THIS week marks National Carers Week, and one organisation is paying tribute to the dedicated workers helping people with disabilities live more independently.

Care Assure, a registered NDIS provider, has been steadily expanding its footprint in regional South Australia, providing essential services to people with complex care needs.

Through its Supported Independent Living (SIL) homes and growing team of support workers, the organisation is helping residents in Whyalla and Port Augusta lead more confident, connected, and fulfilling lives.

“At Care Assure, we’re a proud Australian, NDIS Registered Provider dedicated to empowering people with disabilities to live more independently,” a Care Assure spokesperson said.

“We support participants in Port Augusta, Whyalla and surrounding regions with complex care needs.

“From autism, intellectual disability, brain injury, to dementia - we have proudly supported our clients through some of the toughest phases of their lives, helping them regain confidence and independence,” they said.

The organisation, which has received the NDIS Best Practise after a recent audit, has a range of services that extend beyond day-to-day assistance, offering comprehensive care that adapts to individual needs.

“We provide supported independent liv-

ing, specialist disability accommodation, in-home support, short-term accommodation (respite), and community participation,” the spokesperson said.

“Our friendly and qualified team delivers care that feels like family - whether it’s in the comfort of your home or in one of our welcoming SIL homes in Port Augusta and Whyalla.”

For regional areas such as Whyalla and Port Augusta, access to specialised disabil-

ity accommodation and care has historically been limited.

Recognising the situation, Care Assure has invested heavily in building and operating purpose-designed homes to meet growing demand.

Founded by Adelaide chartered accountant Madeeha Usman, Care Assure was established in 2020 following her personal experiences navigating the NDIS system while caring for her daughter.

What began as a small-scale initiative has since developed into a national network of over 50 purpose-built homes, with further expansion underway in regional South Australia and Tasmania.

Despite early challenges, the organisation has remained focused on its mission to make independent living accessible for all.

Through close collaboration with local builders, nurses and disability support workers, Care Assure has been able to bring more accommodation options and care services to communities that need them most.

The organisation credits much of its success to its regional teams, whose work is particularly celebrated during National Carers Week.

“Over the years, Care Assure has grown across Australia, including Tasmania, thanks to the dedication of our incredible Support Workers and Registered Nurses,” the spokesperson said.

“We’re proud to be part of your community - supporting individuals to live their best lives, every single day.”

With demand for disability services ever-increasing, Care Assure’s expansion in Whyalla and Port Augusta stands as a reminder of how compassion, community and professional care can combine to make lasting change - and how the people behind that care truly deserve recognition this National Carers Week.
